Before you explore

- There is no drinking water or food available outside Thomson Bay and Geordie Bay settlement areas. Make sure you take everything you need with you.
- Do not feed or touch the wildlife. It can make them very sick and cause unnatural and aggressive behaviour. Fines apply.
- Protect the sand dunes by walking on designated access paths and boardwalks.
- Keep the Island beautiful and use rubbish and recycle bins provided.
- Look out for signs and adhere to warnings. Your safety is our concern but your responsibility.
- Mainland laws apply on Rottne this includes compulsory bike helmets.
- There is very little shade around the Island. Make sure you protect yourself from the sun with sunscreen, clothing and a hat.

Getting Around

Bayseeker Bus Service

18 hole Putt – Putt course, ground level trampolines and electronic amusement games.

29 Lomas Cottage (open daily 10.45am – 12.30pm)

The cottage provides an insight into the life of John Lomas an ex-convict and later 'Imperial Pauper' and houses a display of photographs relating to the Island's history.

30 Pilot Boathouse (open daily 2.00pm – 3.30pm)

Check out the exhibition, housed in the original Pilot Boathouse, which honours the work of the sailors who guided incoming ships around the reefs to Fremantle Harbour.

Snorkelling

Spot a Quokka

Standing approximately twelve inches high, this small marsupial is from the Macropodidae family (meaning big foot). The best place to see one during the day is under the trees around Garden Lake or join the daily Rottne Voluntary Guides' free Quokka Tour (visit the Salt Store for more information).

Quokkas are protected, wild animals. Please do not feed or touch the quokkas - It is bad for their health and impacts on their natural survival skills. Fines apply.
