## TERMINALS OF DEPARTURE

### NORTHPORT FERRY TERMINAL

1 Emma Place Rous Head, North Fremantle

Convenient Northport is the locals' departure point of choice, with 400-plus easily accessible car parks for daily and overnight parking. Plus, drive-up luggage drop and a fully licensed kiosk. If you will be arriving under your own steam, Northport is for you. This terminal is best suited for bus parking due to a larger parking area.

**How does it work?** Parking can no longer be pre-purchased so simply turn up on the day to purchase your parking ticket through the parking machines in the carpark at the Fremantle (Northport) terminal. Carpark remains open until 15 minutes after the last service arrives at Northport each day.

Note that there is no public transport to Northport and the Fremantle Port Authority doesn't permit cycling in the Rous Head precinct (there's no safe cycle lane). Cyclists should ride and/or catch the train to B Shed at Victoria Quay instead.

### B SHED FERRY TERMINAL

1 Peter Hughes Drive, Fremantle

**\*Please Note:** That the B Shed terminal is currently under renovations, and we are operating out of an office on the E Shed side of Peter Hughes Drive. Due to the summer period parking will be extremely busy in and around our Fremantle terminal, we encourage you to leave plenty of time to find appropriate parking or alternatively travel out of our Northport terminal in Rous Head for ample parking options.

For day-trippers and passengers coming from south of the Swan River, B Shed is the most convenient Rottnest Island departure point. It is also close to Fremantle train station, so if you are arriving via public transport, you will be just a short walk from your ferry. Very limited long-term parking is available from \$10 per day with Wilson Parking.

### BARRACK STREET JETTY FERRY TERMINAL

Pier 4 Elizabeth Quay, Perth CBD

Barrack Street Jetty is in a prime position on the Perth riverfront, next to the booming Elizabeth Quay tourist precinct. Rottnest Express staff are on hand to help you make the most of your visit to Perth and Rottnest, as you sidestep Perth's traffic and enjoy a picturesque Swan River cruise en route to the island. Parking can be tight in downtown Perth, but public transport is nearby – both the Elizabeth Quay train station and the Barrack Street Jetty stop on the free Blue CAT bus line. A free city hotel pickup service is also available from selected hotels.

### DISCOVER ROTTNEST BUS TOUR

### SNORKEL HIRE







## OVERNIGHT STAYS

Staying on Rottnest Island will not only allow more time to explore the beautiful island, but it will also be an unforgettable experience. The Rottnest Island Authority offer a wide range of accommodation options on the Island, from campsites all the way to ocean view cabins and hotels.

### BEST SUITED FOR SCHOOL GROUPS

#### Campground

The Campground contains 43 non-powered campsites available, each site can accommodate up to 6 people and two tents.

#### Governors Circle

Governors Circle are self-contained cottages near Kingston Barracks that can fit up to 9-13 guests or 18 bed configurations.

#### Caroline Thomson

Cabins located close to the main settlement, each cabin fits up to 6 people and has a fully fitted-out kitchen.

#### Rottnest Hostel

50 beds with a fully equipped kitchen and lounge.

#### Kingston Barracks

Historic WWII Barracks, less than 2km from the settlement. Plenty of rooms, beds and communal areas.

### LUGGAGE

Hand luggage can be taken aboard the ferry when travelling to and from the island and anything bigger can be placed in a pickup crate or it delivered if tagged correctly. Depending on the size of the group, we are able to allocate crates for the groups journey which do not require individual item tagging. Crates are best used for food, drinks, luggage and extra items/activities for students. Crates and loose items with our luggage labels are delivered to accommodation by the island business Programmed. Collection on the return journey is also provided, the time of collection will be advised at check in at the Visitor Centre. - Rottnest Express.

### TAKE A QUOKKA SELFIE


Quokkas can be found all over Rottnest Island. These adorable creatures are particularly special because they often appear to smile widely.

Remember that quokkas are wild animals and should not be touched or fed, always maintain a respectful distance with the animals at all times and never disturb them while resting or sleeping.



### WILDLIFE SPOTTING

In addition to quokkas, you can observe various bird species, including sea birds and migratory species while walking around the island.



### SNORKEL THE REEFS & SWIM THE BAYS

Adventure awaits snorkelers eager to explore the underwater scenery, home to more than 135 species of colourful tropical fish and 20 varieties of coral.


